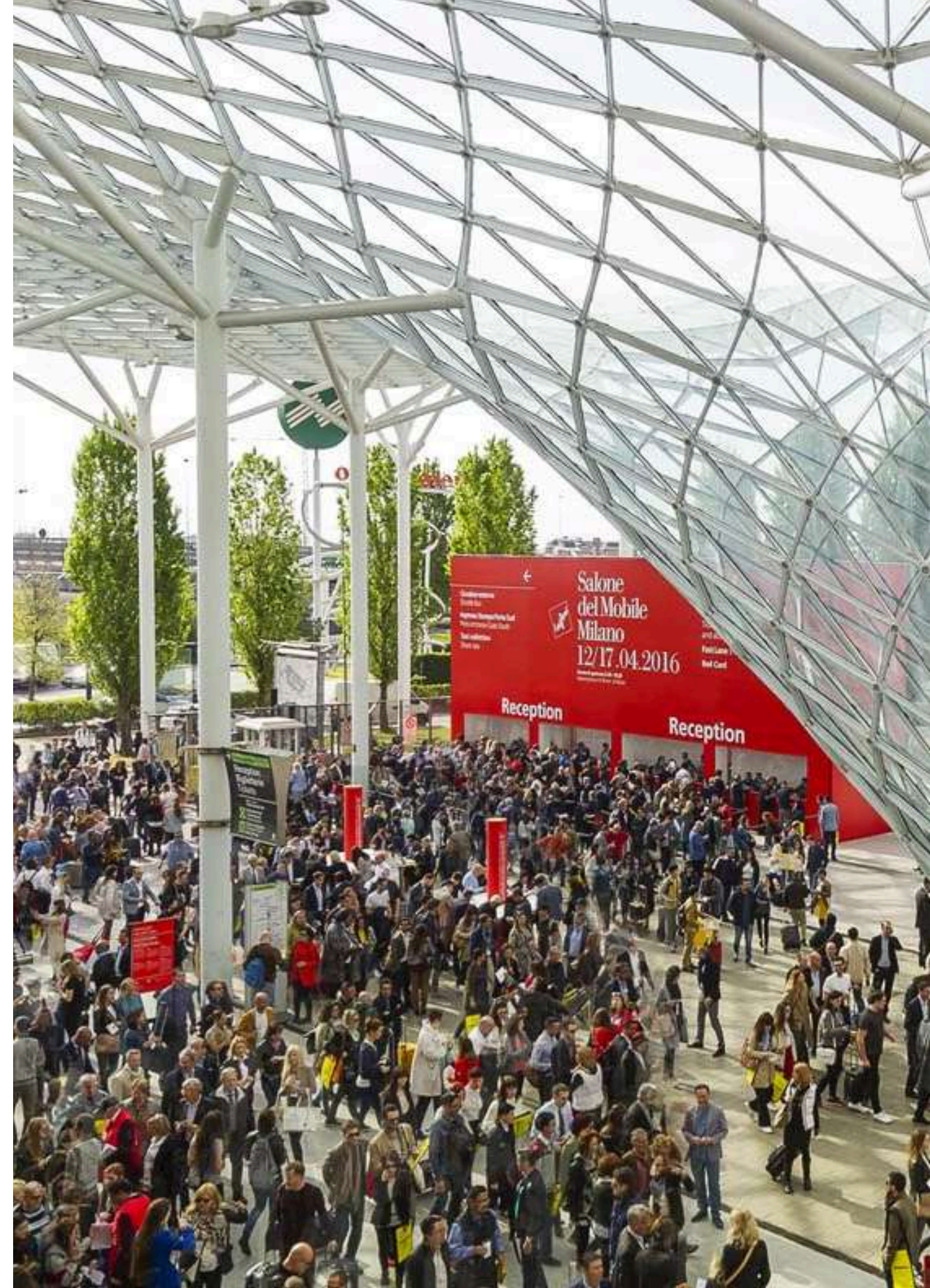

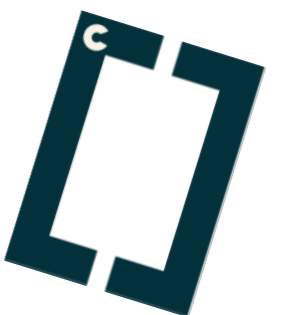
Introduction

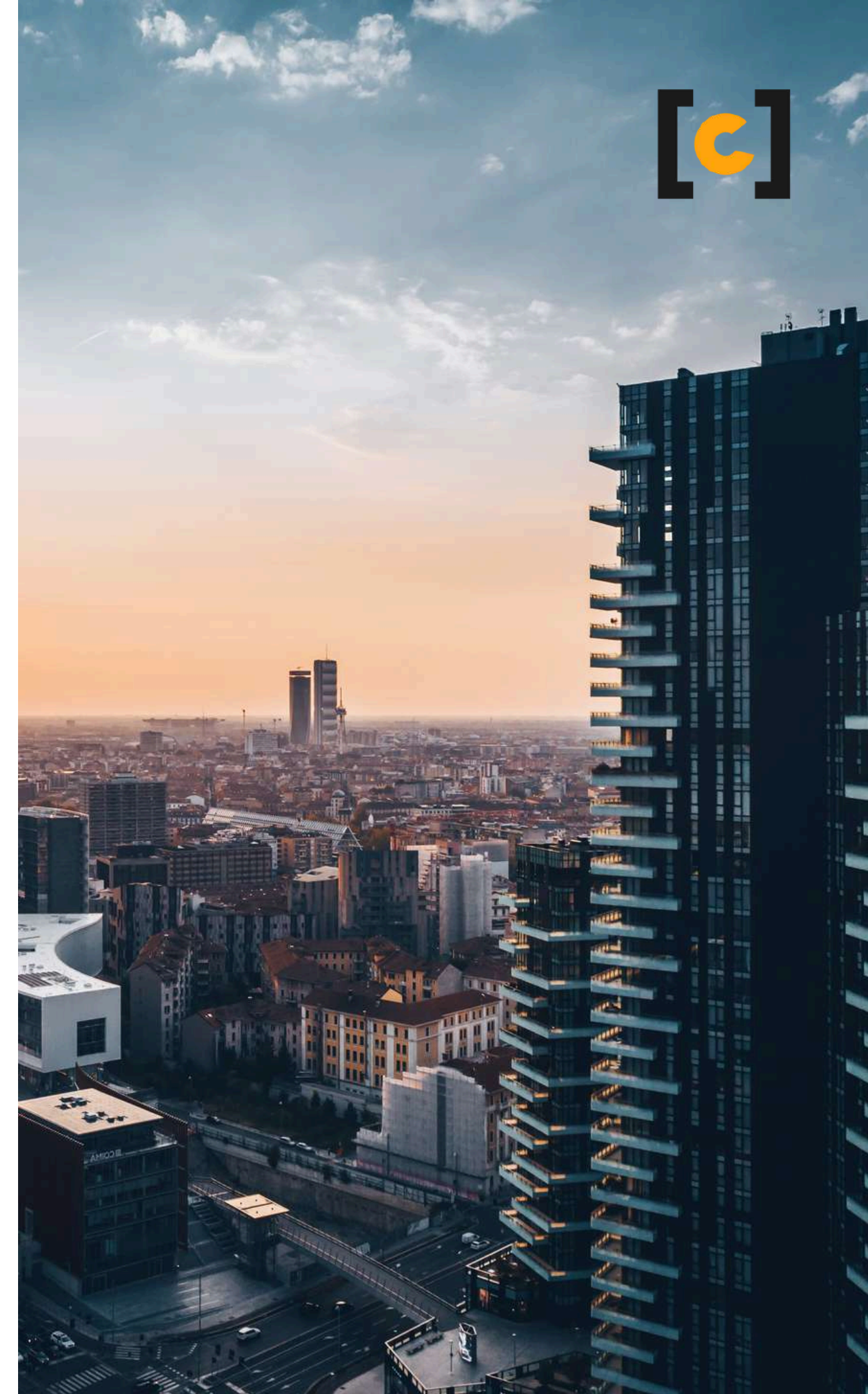

It serves as a hub for networking, unveiling industry trends, and fostering new international partnerships.



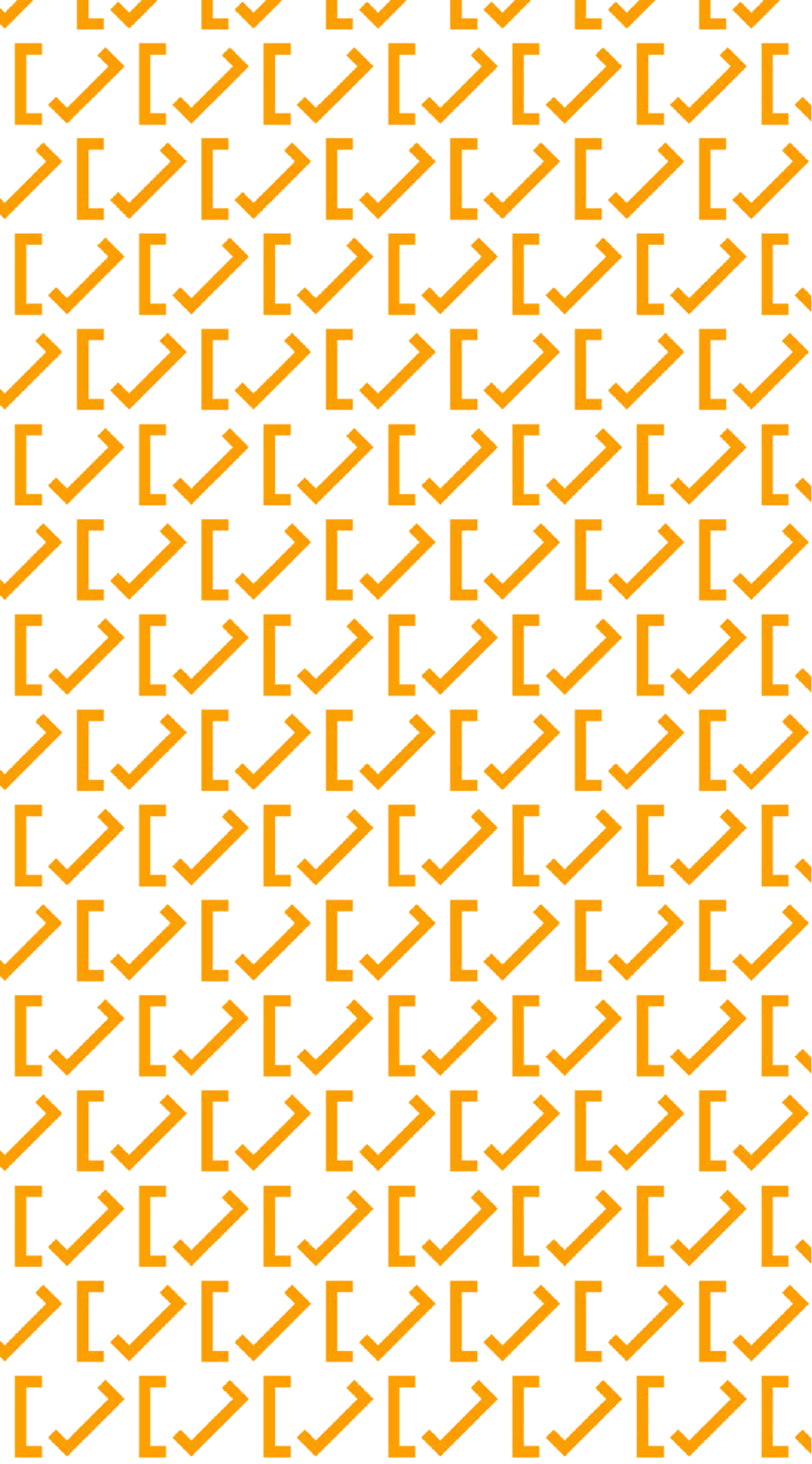
Evolving markets and growth opportunities

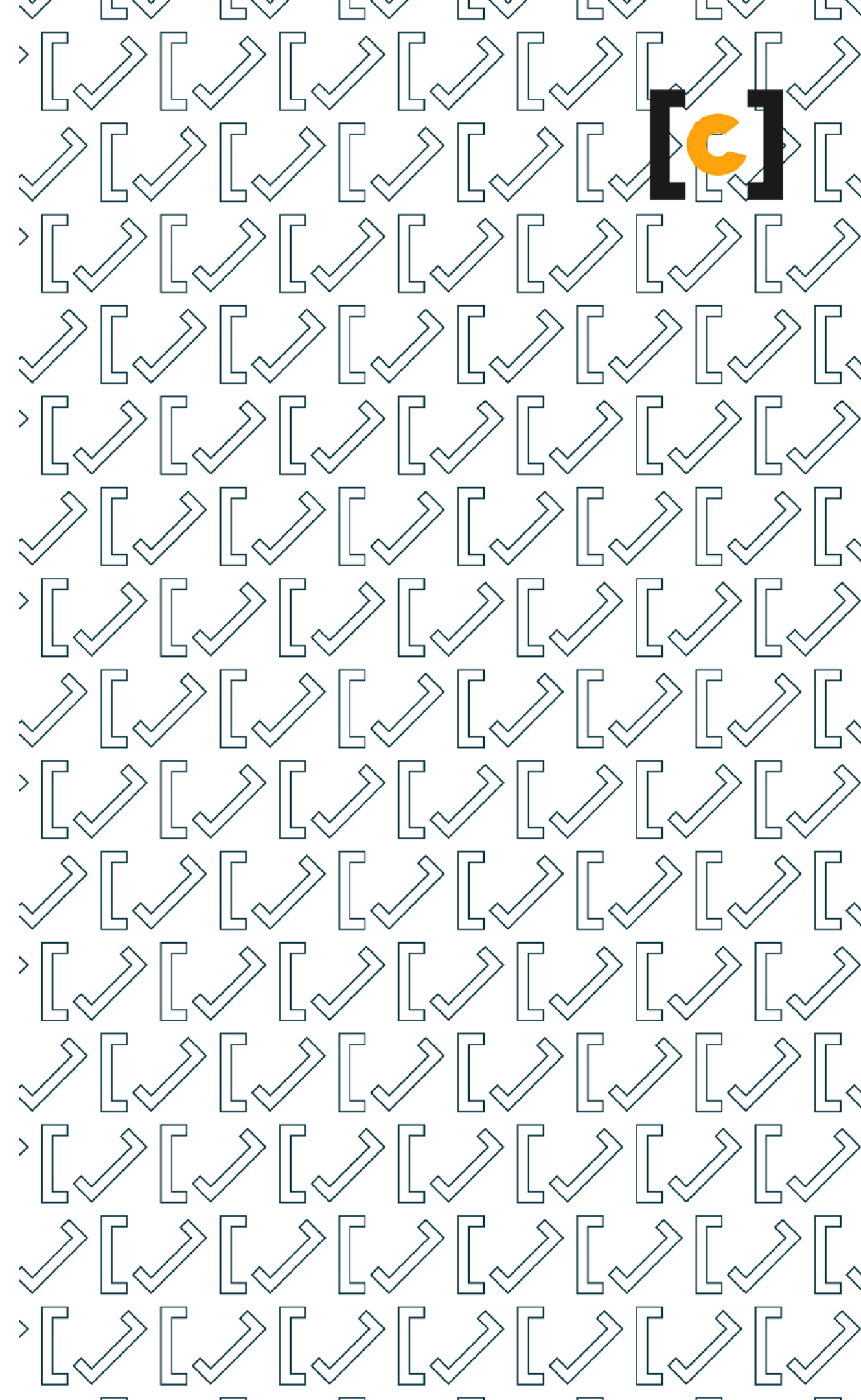

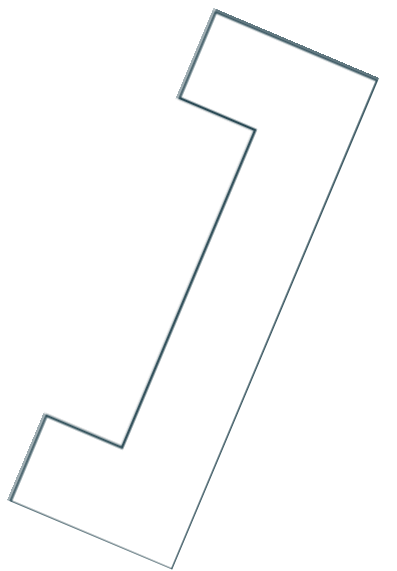
